Good Afternoon!

We hope everyone has had a great week!

As we move into the second week of August, our crews continue navigating Southwest Florida's typical summer weather patterns while remaining focused on delivering quality landscape maintenance services. Frequent afternoon thunderstorms, elevated temperatures, and high humidity continue to influence daily operations, and our teams remain committed to making sound field decisions that protect the long-term health of your landscape. However we can all agree, rain is a good thing!

Items Completed This Week:

Our crews successfully completed all scheduled:

- Weekly mowing
- Line trimming
- Hard edging
- Forced-air cleanup
- Community-wide shrub trimming and detail pruning
- Landscape quality inspections throughout the community
- Agronomic inspections and monitoring for turf insects and disease
- Ongoing monitoring of drainage and turf recovery following recent rainfall events

With this week's completion of the community-wide trimming cycle, the landscape is well-positioned heading into the remainder of the growing season. Additionally, **Mount Tumalo is scheduled to be mowed within the next two weeks** as part of our continuing maintenance schedule.

As always, our goal is to maintain a clean, healthy, and aesthetically pleasing community while making field decisions that protect the landscape from unnecessary stress or damage.

Weather Update

Southwest Florida continues to experience a typical summer weather pattern with scattered afternoon thunderstorms and periods of intense heat and humidity. Rainfall remains highly localized, with some areas receiving several inches while neighboring communities receive significantly less. These conditions continue to promote vigorous turf growth while also increasing pressure from weeds, insects, and fungal diseases.

Our Agronomic Team continues monitoring these seasonal conditions closely and will make recommendations or treatments as necessary to maintain the health and appearance of the landscape.

Looking into next week, daily afternoon rain chances remain in the forecast with temperatures expected to remain in the low 90s and heat index values frequently exceeding 100°F.

Looking Ahead to Next Week

Should the community receive excessive rainfall, portions of the property may be temporarily skipped until soil conditions are suitable for commercial mowing equipment, edging, etc.

Operating heavy equipment on saturated soils can:

- Create ruts and tire tracks
- Damage turf root systems
- Cause soil compaction
- Pull weakened turf from the ground
- Leave visible damage that can take weeks to recover

While delaying service is never our preferred approach, protecting the long-term health of the turf will always remain our priority. Areas temporarily postponed will be revisited as soon as conditions safely allow.

Irrigation & Landscape Monitoring

Our teams will continue monitoring:

- Irrigation system performance and coverage
- Turf recovery and overall plant health
- Insect activity, including chinch bugs, armyworms, sod webworms, and mole crickets
- Seasonal fungal disease activity
- Landscape quality and overall curb appeal

As always, irrigation is intended to supplement natural rainfall not to replace it. Our irrigation and agronomic teams will continue making adjustments and recommendations as weather conditions evolve throughout the summer.
