Good morning, Everyone,

We hope everyone has had a great week!

As we move into the last week of July, our crews continue adapting daily to Southwest Florida's ever-changing weather patterns. From localized heavy rainfall to periods of intense heat and humidity, our teams remain focused on protecting the long-term health of your landscape while maintaining the highest level of service possible.

Items Completed This Week:

Our crews successfully completed all scheduled:

Weekly mowing

Line trimming

Hard edging

Forced-air cleanup

Routine shrub maintenance (where applicable)

Irrigation inspections, adjustments, and repairs (where applicable)

Landscape quality inspections throughout the community

Agronomic inspections and monitoring for turf insects and disease

Mole cricket treatment in all Bermuda turf areas (where applicable)

As always, our goal is to maintain a clean, healthy, and aesthetically pleasing community while making field decisions that protect the landscape from unnecessary stress or damage.

Weather Update

This week brought a more typical Southwest Florida summer weather pattern, with scattered afternoon thunderstorms developing throughout the region. While many communities received beneficial rainfall, totals continued to vary dramatically, with some neighborhoods receiving multiple inches while others saw only brief showers. The combination of increased rainfall, high humidity, and daytime temperatures in the low to mid-90s has accelerated turf growth in many areas while also creating favorable conditions for weeds, insects, and fungal diseases. Our Agronomic Team continues to closely monitor these seasonal pressures and respond proactively where necessary.

Looking ahead into the weekend and early next week, scattered afternoon thunderstorms remain in the forecast with temperatures expected to remain in the low 90s and heat index values approaching or exceeding 100°F. As always, rainfall will remain highly localized across the area.

Looking Ahead to Next Week

If the community receives significant rainfall over the weekend, our crews may temporarily postpone mowing in saturated areas until soils become firm enough to safely support commercial equipment.

Operating heavy zero-turn mowers on wet ground can:

- Create ruts and tire tracks.

- Damage turf root systems.

- Cause soil compaction.

- Pull weakened turf from the ground.

- Leave visible damage that may take weeks to recover.

While skipping an area is never our first choice, protecting the long-term health of the turf will always take priority over mowing under poor conditions. These areas will be revisited as soon as conditions allow.

Likewise, portions of the community that continue to receive below-average rainfall may still exhibit signs of drought stress despite scattered showers elsewhere. Recovery from prolonged drought remains a gradual process requiring consistent moisture over time.

Irrigation & Landscape Monitoring

Our teams will continue monitoring:

Irrigation system performance and coverage

Turf recovery and overall plant health

Insect activity, including chinch bugs, armyworms, sod webworms, and mole crickets

Seasonal fungal disease activity

Drainage patterns and saturated soil conditions

Landscape quality and overall curb appeal

As a reminder, irrigation is designed to supplement natural rainfall not replace it. Even properly functioning irrigation systems have limitations during periods of prolonged drought or when rainfall becomes inconsistent. Our irrigation and agronomic teams will continue making recommendations and adjustments as conditions evolve.
